



Intestinal Upset Diet

If your pet has been diagnosed with an intestinal upset, it is recommended that you do not feed your pet for 24 hours so that the intestinal tract can rest. Always make sure that they have water available so they do not get dehydrated. When you do start to offer solid food again, please feed your pet the following diet for the next two days. After that you can start to work them back onto their regular diet.

- Boil 1 pound of lean ground beef, turkey or chicken in water for approximately 15 minutes or until completely cooked.
- Put in colander and rinse off any grease with warm water.
- Mix the meat with an equal part of cooked WHITE rice, such as Minute Rice. Please don't use brown rice....
- Feed your pet according to the table below:

If their weight is approximately:

5-20 lbs: Feed $\frac{1}{2}$ cup every 12 hours
21-40lbs: Feed 1 cup every 12 hours
41-60lbs: Feed $1\frac{1}{2}$ cups every 12 hours
61-80lbs: Feed 2 cups every 12 hours
Over 80 lbs: Feed $2\frac{1}{2}$ cups every 12 hours
